


Iverhampton

Our nurseries

Our staff team follow the Early Years Foundation Stage Statutory Framework (EYFS) with all age groups of children; they observe and record each child's progress and will discuss each stage with parents/carers to ensure a partnership approach to learning is developed. We will take you through our parenting pack which helps everyone get to know each other from our ethos to yours. Our nurseries are purpose built and provide childcare for children between the ages of 0 - 5. Our aim is to create a "Home away from Home" atmosphere, where your children can flourish and learn. We understand that you as parents and carers are your child's first educators. It is our aim to work closely in partnership with you to meet your child's needs and support them to reach their full potential.

We operate a key worker system within Nursery, meaning that your child will be supported to build confidence and positive relationships with others through guidance and continuity. Your child's needs are always our main concern, which is why we operate an "open door" policy where Parents and Carers are welcomed into the Nursery at any time to join in with our activities, or come and speak with your Key Worker to find out about your child's progress. We implement a mixture of indoor and outdoor activities, in order to allow your child the best opportunity to develop essential skills needed to promote healthy development.
